Timeline & Rules

Eligibility → Open to all California residents - See Rule 2.

Entry Forms Due → On or before **Friday, June 8**, 5 pm, Fair Office

Note: You may enter online at marinfair.org through Friday, June 22

Entry Limit → One Entry per Exhibitor per Class.

Entry Fee → \$5 Per Entry – Fee must accompany Entry Form.

Exhibits Received → Friday, June 29, 7:30 am to 10:00 am, Exhibit Hall

Exhibits Released → Thursday, July 5, 12 Noon to 7 pm, Exhibit Hall

1. Local and State Rules govern this competition.
2. Open to Professional Florists, Floral Event Designers, and anyone who has received compensation for floral arranging.
3. Exhibitor may enter multiple Departments and Classes on one Entry Form. (Example: You may enter Floriculture, Floral Arts, and Horticulture on one Entry Form.)
4. **Arrangement Requirements:**
 - a. Exhibits must not occupy an area more than 48" wide and x 60" tall.
 - b. Exhibitors are expected to use free interpretation of all titles.
 - c. State conservation material is not permitted for use in exhibits.
 - d. Foliage is permitted in all arrangements unless otherwise stated in the schedule. Succulents are classed as foliage.
 - e. Some fresh plant material or flowers, fruit or foliage is required in all arrangements unless otherwise stated in these rules.
 - f. No artificial fruit, flowers, vegetables or foliage may be used except in those classes listed in the Exhibitors' Guide. Sprayed, glycerinated or any other treated natural material will be considered dry material. Dry material may be used for line material except where fresh material is indicated. No fresh plant material may be sprayed.
 - g. Material used in arrangements need not have been grown by exhibitor.
 - h. All containers, mats and accessories must be marked with the name of the exhibitor on the bottom.
5. Coordinator will refresh arrangements daily. If you do not want an entry watered, please notify the Coordinator at time of delivery.
6. The Coordinator reserves the right to remove wilted or spoiled material from any exhibit.
7. Refer to previous divisions for scorecard for Arrangements.

Professional Classes (Themes)

- 1 **World Unity** – Connect three containers in a harmonious way.
- 2 **Ebony and Ivory** – A black and white statement of your choice.
- 3 **South of the Border** – Use one or more terra cotta pots as containers or props.
- 4 **Pretty in Pink** – Use one or more shades of pink.
- 5 **Flaming Flamenco** – A dancing red and black statement.
- 6 **Gone Fishing!** – Flowers, foliage and fishing related props.
- 7 **The Tradewinds** – Lots of movement through flowers, foliage and props.
- 8 **Masquerade Ball** – Use one or more masks.
- 9 **Varied Veggies!** – Be creative with vegetables, flowers and/or foliage.
- 10 **High Noon!** – A vibrant vertical statement!
- 11 **Niagara Falls** – Cascading flowers and foliage.
- 12 **The World of Music** – Your interpretation.
- 13 **Rock On!** – Use one of more rocks/stones/pebbles in your arrangement.
- 14 **Number One Fan!** – Use one of more folding fans in your arrangement.
- 15 **The Dubs!** – Celebrate the Golden State Warriors!
- 16 **The Wild Wild West** – Your choice using all dried material.
- 17 **Foliage Follies!** – Use all foliage with props. No flowering material.
- 18 **Pacific Sunset** – Your choice using all silk and artificial material.
