Timeline & Rules

Entry Forms Due → On or before Thursday,
May 10, 5 pm, Fair Office

Note: You may enter online at marinfair.org through Friday, June 1

**Please enter early. Space is limited. When area is full,
no more entries will be accepted.**

Entry Fee → \$3.50 Per Class, including groups **Entry Limit** → None
No entry fee for showmanship. Entry Fees must accompany Entry Forms.

Arrival Time → Saturday, June 30, 7 am to 9 am

Judging Time → Saturday, June 30, 12:30 pm
Showmanship followed by individual classes

Departure Time → Saturday, June 30, approximately 6 pm

1. Local and State Rules Govern this Competition.
2. Open to 4-H, FFA, and Independent Junior exhibitors 8 years through 19 years of age from California. Age as of January 1, 2018, except for special juniors who must be 5 years old as of June 30, 2018.
3. All animals must be N.P.G.A. registered. Copies of registration papers may be sent with entry, or they may be checked the morning of the show.
4. Health Check: Only healthy animals may be entered. Any animals having runny noses and/or eyes or other obvious signs of illness will be requested to leave. The decision made by the show committee is final and entry fees will not be refunded.
5. Exhibitors must be bonafide owner of all entries 60 days prior to the show.
6. Classes may be combined, if there are less than three entries per class.
7. The AMERICAN SYSTEM OF JUDGING will be used in all classes.
8. 4-H and FFA members must wear official uniforms in the ring for both showmanship and breed classes. Independent juniors must wear ankle length white pants and a white blouse or shirt.
9. Bedding, (straw), will be provided by Fair.
10. Exhibitors must clean their stalls before departure.
11. Horned Pygmy Goats are allowed in the show.

- 22 **Daughter Dam** To consist of a daughter and dam of any age.

Division 861 Pygmy Goat Showmanship

- No entry fee, but please include showmanship on your entry form.
- No cash awards for showmanship. Rosettes First through Ninth Place.

Class (See Rule #2 for age requirements.)

- 23 Novice Showmanship, exhibitor has never competed in Pygmy Goat Showmanship, all ages
- 24 Primary Showmanship, 5 through 8 years of age
- 25 Junior Showmanship, 9 through 13 years of age
- 26 Senior Showmanship, 14 years and over



Youth placing First and Second in Junior and Senior Showmanship are invited to compete in Round Robin Showmanship, Tuesday, July 3.
