Rules –

1. Open to all High School Students who are residents of Marin County and have just completed their Junior or Senior year in a Marin school.
2. Each entry is to consist of 5 pieces of art that the student has completed during their junior and/or senior year. You may list separate titles for each piece on entry form if you wish.
3. Any combination of artwork may be entered. (Examples: 1 sculpture and 4 paintings; 5 photographs; 2 paintings, 1 drawing, 1 ceramic piece, and 1 sculpture; 4 paintings and 1 photograph; etc.)
4. Label back or bottom of each entry with your name and phone number.
5. Please submit a brief typed description (not more than one page) of your artwork and your artistic aspirations. This will be displayed with your work, so must be matted or framed and ready to hang.
6. Refer to beginning of department for additional rules and deadlines for submitting entry forms and delivering and picking up entries.
