Mailed Video Deadline → Thursday, June 7, 5 pm, Fair Office

Videos Received → **2 Days** Friday, June 8, 3 pm to 7 pm &
Saturday, June 9, 10 am to 5 pm, Exhibit Hall

Entry Fee → No Entry Fee

Entries Released → Thursday, July 5, 12 Noon to 7 pm, Exhibit Hall

*Mailed entries will not be returned unless a self-addressed, stamped envelope
is included with entry. Entries must otherwise be picked up at Fair Office.*

Rules -

- 1. Eligibility:** Open to students 9 through 18 years of age.
- 2. Production Timeline:** Videos must have been completed after January 1, 2018.
- 3. Subject Matter:** Your video may be of any subject matter. Please list title of video as description on entry form.
- 4. Accepted Entry Format:** All entrants must submit a **QuickTime** file, **mp4** file, or a **YouTube** link. No other formats will be accepted.
- 5. How to Enter:**
 - a.** Enter online at **marinfair.org**, or deliver entry form to Fair Office, 10 Avenue of the Flags, San Rafael CA 94093.
 - b.** Mail or hand-deliver video to Fair Office -or- email video (attachment or YouTube link) to **MCFairDigital@gmail.com**. Include your name & contact information on CD/flash drive or in email content.
- 6. Running Time:** Maximum running time for all formats is 5 minutes.
- 7. Copyright Laws:** All music & other copyright material used in films and videos must be original or be used by permission of author or publisher.
- 8. Promotion:** Publicity materials & photos should be included with entries.
- 9. Public Screening:** Winning entries will be shown at the Marin County Fair, June 30 through July 4. Fairgoers encompass a large and diverse audience, often including young children. Films that are considered offensive or unsuitable for children will not be selected for viewing.
