Timeline & Rules

Entry Forms Due → On or before Thursday, May 16, 5 pm, Fair Office

Or Enter online, marinfair.org, through Monday, June 3

A 2019 Registration Fee of \$2 per person will apply; save \$1 by entering online.
Please enter early. Space is limited.

When area is full, no more entries will be accepted.

Entry Fee → \$3.50 per entry per Class, including groups

No entry fee for showmanship. Entry Fees must accompany Entry Forms.

Entry Limit → Twelve animals per exhibitor.

Arrival Time → Wednesday, July 3, 7 am to 9 am

Judging Time → Wednesday, July 3, Noon, beginning with kids, dry yearlings, milking does, and Showmanship (youngest exhibitors to oldest).

Departure Time → Wednesday, July 3, approximately 6 pm

1. Local and State Rules Govern this Competition.
2. Open to 4-H, FFA, and Independent Junior exhibitors 8 years through 19 years of age from California. Age as of January 1, 2019, except for special juniors, who must, be 8 years old as of July 3, 2019.
3. All animals must be registered. Copies of registration papers may be sent with entry, or they may be checked the morning of the show.
4. Exhibitors must be bonafide owner of all entries 30 days prior to the Fair.
5. Classes may be combined, if there are less than three entries per class.
6. The AMERICAN SYSTEM OF JUDGING will be used in all classes.
7. 4-H and FFA members must wear official uniforms in the ring for both showmanship and breed classes. Independent juniors must wear ankle length white pants and a white blouse or shirt.
8. Straw bedding will be provided by the Fair.
9. **Exhibitors must clean their stalls before departure.**

Groups All animals owned by one exhibitor, entered as individuals, and of one breed. Groups must be shown. Registered and Grades may not be combined for group classes.

- 18 **Get of Sire** Three does sired by same buck, at least one to be a yearling or older in milk. One entry by same buck per exhibitor.
- 19 **Best Three Females** Three does of any age, need not be related, but of the same breed. One entry per exhibitor.
- 20 **Produce of Dam** Two does, produce of same dam. One entry by same dam per exhibitor. The dam must be identified by registration number on entry form.
- 21 **Daughter and Dam** Two animals, a dam and her daughter of any age. The dam must be identified by registration number on entry form.
