Timeline & Rules

Entry Forms Due → On or before Thursday, May 16, 5 pm, Fair Office
Include the breed & name of your dog on Entry Form.
All classes must be included on Entry Form
(*exception:* Costume Class may be added on the day of show if other classes had been entered by deadline)

Or: Enter online at marinfair.org through Monday, June 3.

A 2019 Registration Fee of \$2 per person will apply; save \$1 by entering online.

Entry Fee → \$10 per Exhibitor – One Entry Fee includes all classes entered by one exhibitor plus one Fair admission credential and one combined admission/parking credential. Refer to Rule #2e below.

Entry Limit → You may enter all divisions

Location → Clover Sonoma Farm Arena

Arrival Time → Thursday, July 4, 8:15 am to 9:00 am

Judging → Thursday, July 4:

9 am to 10 am – Showmanship

10 am to 11:30 am – Obstacle Course

11:30 pm – 12:30 pm Costume Contest followed by Parade

Departure Time → Thursday, July 4, Immediately after Show

- 1. Eligibility:** Open to all California juniors (4-H and non-4-H) 5 through 19 years of age. The dog, mixed breed or purebred, must be owned by the exhibitor or their immediate family and been in a dog training program.
- 2. Rules:**
 - a.** Dog must have been obedience trained and fitted for showmanship by immediate family members.
 - b.** Bitches in season will not be permitted to compete.
 - c.** Uncontrolled or aggressive dogs will not be allowed to compete.
 - d.** All dogs must be on leash at all times, unless in an off-leash class.
 - e.** **A dog may be shown by more than one family member, but each family member showing the dog must pay the \$10 entry fee.**
 - f.** Dogs must remain in Clover Sonoma Farm Arena during show.
- 3. Credentials:** Each exhibitor will receive one admission credential and one combined admission/parking credential. (One parking credential per family.) You will also receive a map showing directions to the Fairgrounds.
- 4. Entry Forms & Fees:** Enter online at marinfair.org or mail entry forms and fees to the Fair Entry Office, 415.473.7048.

Division 841 Obstacle Course

Note: Obstacle Course - To consist of 17 stations; some rally, some agility, some obedience – all fun. On leash, one dog at a time. Start with 100 points and deductions made for dog errors. Dog & handler with shortest time and fewest deductions wins. After entries are received a list of the specific stations will be sent to each exhibitor.

- 1 Primary Obstacle Course, 5 through 8 years of age
- 2 Junior Obstacle Course, 9 through 12 years of age
- 3 Senior Obstacle Course, 13 years of age and older
