2020 Registration Fee: \$1 per person online, \$2 per person via paper form

Entry Limit → **One Entry per Exhibitor per Class**

Entry Fee → **\$6 per entry**

Exhibits Received → **Friday, June 5, 3 pm to 7 pm &
Saturday, June 6, 10 am to 5 pm, Exhibit Hall**

Exhibits Released → **Tuesday, July 7, 12 Noon to 7 pm, Exhibit Hall**

1. Local and State Rules govern this competition.
2. **Eligibility:** Open to all residents of the USA. Exhibitors 5 through 18 refer to Division 310.
3. **Entry Procedure:** Please follow the timeline listed above.
4. **Materials Used:** Any type of chair may be used -- Wooden, Metal, Plastic, Upholstered, etc. Chairs may be entirely hand made by exhibitor or purchased, including purchased flea market specials. There are no restrictions on the materials you can use to decorate your entry – paint, fabric, three-dimensional embellishments, themed items, found objects, etc. Be creative!
5. **Sales:** Please indicate sale price or not for sale (N.F.S.) on entry form. Marin County Fair will retain a 25% commission. Sales will be handled through the Fair Office. Artists will be paid by check approximately three weeks following the Fair. Note: Sales Price may not be changed after entry form is submitted.
6. **Exhibit Reclaim:** Exhibits must be picked-up on Tuesday, July 7 between 12 Noon and 7 pm, Marin Center Exhibit Hall. **Entries must be picked up on time to receive any awarded prizes.**
7. **Liability:** Every precaution will be taken to ensure the safe handling of exhibits; however, the Fair will not be responsible for any loss or damage which may occur from any cause.
