2. **Entry Procedure:** Register online at marinfair.org or submit Entry Form then deliver your work on Receiving Days listed above. Registration & entry must be received by corresponding dates listed above.
3. **Exhibit Reclaim:** Entries must be picked up on release day. Entries will only be released by presenting your claim check, personal identification, or a signed letter of authorization from the exhibitor.
4. **Liability:** Every precaution will be taken in the handling and exhibiting of work; however, the Fair will not be responsible for loss or damage which may occur from any cause. Submission of entries implies acceptance of all conditions stated in these rules.
5. **General:** Accepted works shall NOT BE REMOVED from the show prior to pickup dates as stated in these rules. Works must remain as installed.

Entry Fee – \$3.50 per entry

- Rules - 1.** Decorate a clean gourd (surface dirt & membrane removed).
Gourd may be any size or shape.
- 2.** Any technique or combination of techniques may be used – Examples: Beading, Weaving, Mosaic, Inlay, Carving, Pen & Ink, Decoupage, Etc.
- 3.** Any combination of applied materials may be used – Examples: beads, flowers, pebbles, pine needles, seeds, grains, etc.
- 4.** The first twenty-five adult exhibitors to register may pick up a free gourd to decorate from the Fair Office beginning April 15.
