1. Decorate a clean gourd (remove surface dirt & membrane) of any size or shape.
 2. Any combination of techniques may be used. (e.g. beading, weaving, mosaic, inlay, coloring (paint, stain, or dye), carving, woodburning, decoupage, etc.)
 3. Any combination of applied materials may be used. (e.g. beads, flowers, pebbles, pine needles, seeds, grains, etc.)
 4. The first fifty junior exhibitors to enter may pick up a free gourd to decorate from the Fair Office beginning April 15.
