Rules –

1. Open to all Marin County High School Students who have just completed their Junior or Senior year.
2. Each entry is to consist of five pieces of art (or five high-quality 8x10 photos, one of each piece of art) that you completed during your junior and/or senior year. This will enable students that send their work to other competitions to enter their art at the Fair. You may list separate titles for each piece if you wish.
3. Any combination of artwork may be entered. (Examples: 1 sculpture and 4 paintings; 5 photographs; 2 paintings, 1 drawing, 1 ceramic piece, and 1 sculpture; 4 paintings and 1 photograph; etc.)
4. Label back or bottom of each entry with your name and phone number.
5. **Required:** Please include a brief typed description (one 8" x 11" page) of your artwork and your artistic aspirations. This will be displayed with your work, so must be matted or framed and ready to hang.
6. Refer to beginning of department for additional rules and deadlines for submitting entry forms and delivering and picking up entries.
