No Entry Fee.

Refer to beginning of Department for delivery dates.

Rules -

1. All entries must be original design and the work of the artist.
2. Size Limit: Entries may not exceed 48" in any direction.
3. Put your name, phone number, division, and class number on the back of entry.
4. Two Dimensional entries are to be matted or framed. Framed pieces need to have screw eyes and braided wire on back for hanging.

Entry Limit: One entry per Exhibitor per Class (one painting, one drawing, etc.)

Class (For all four Junior Art Divisions listed above)

Two Dimensional:

- 1 Collage
- 2 Drawing - Felt pen, pencils, charcoal, chalk, crayon, scratch art, etc.
- 3 Painting - Acrylic, oil, watercolor, tempera, finger painting, Asian brush, etc.
- 4 Printmaking, any type – citrus, vegetable, stamp, woodcuts, linoleum, etc.
- 5 Digital Art - Art created with a computer
- 6 Self-Portrait, painting, drawing or any combination – You may include a snapshot of yourself with your original self-portrait.
- 7 Tangle Art (Zentangle® Style), black & white or color

Two or Three Dimensional:

- 8 Mixed Media, any combination
- 9 Recycled Art - Art created from any recycled objects
- 10 *The Soaring 2020s*, any work of art depicting the Marin County Fair theme

Three Dimensional:

- 11 Ceramics
- 12 Sculpture - wood, metal, paper maché, or any other medium
