**Eligibility** → Open to California residents.

**Entry Limit** → Two Entries per Class, unless otherwise noted

## Adult Division 46 Trash to Treasure

**Entry Fee – \$3.50 per entry**

### Rules -

1. Recycle any material to make a new item, which may be functional or decorative. Examples - recycled wood furniture, recycled plastic bottle bird feeder, recycled paper greeting cards, etc.
2. Any combination of material may be used (fabric, cardboard, plastic, wood, etc).

*Note: Adult, Family, or Group classes below; refer to Junior Arts & Crafts for the Junior Trash to Treasure Art Division.*

### Class

- 1 Trash to Treasure, up to 24" in any direction – made by an adult
- 2 Trash to Treasure, 25" to 48" in any direction – made by an adult
- 3 Trash to Treasure, over 48" in any direction – made by an adult
- 4 Trash to Treasure, functional furniture – made by an adult
- 5 Trash to Treasure, any made by a family or a group of two or more adults
