### **Rules -**

- 1. Eligibility:** Open to youths 9 through 18 years of age.
- 2. Production Timeline:** Videos must have been completed after January 1, 2020.
- 3. Accepted Entry Format:** All entrants must submit a **QuickTime** file, **mp4** file, or a **YouTube** link (posting must remain available through the duration of the fair to qualify). No other formats will be accepted.
- 4. How to Enter:**
  - a.** Register online at [marinfair.org](http://marinfair.org) or deliver entry form to Fair Office.
  - b.** Email video file or link to [MCFairDigital@gmail.com](mailto:MCFairDigital@gmail.com). Include your name, contact information, class, & video title in email content.
  - c.** Submission is only valid upon receipt of a confirmation email.
- 5. Running Time:** Maximum running time for all formats is 5 minutes.
- 6. Copyright Laws:** All music & other copyright material used in films and videos must be original or be used by permission of author or publisher.
- 7. Promotion:** Publicity materials & photos should be included with entries.
- 8. Subject Matter:** Your video may be of any subject matter deemed appropriate for our public screening by jurors &/or Fair staff.
- 9. Public Screening:** Winning entries will be shown at the Marin County Fair, July 1-5, 2020. Fairgoers encompass a large and diverse audience, often including young children. Films that are considered offensive or unsuitable for children will not be selected for viewing.
