Rules -- 1. Local and State Rules govern this competition.

2. Exhibitors must follow timelines. Entries delivered outside of times designated above will not be judged.

3. All entries must be home-prepared by the exhibitor.

4. All baked foods must be properly labeled with name, phone number, division number, & class number on bottom of container (preferably disposable). Display Coordinator reserves the right to remove any dish/stand from display. All returnable stands, dishes, tins, etc. must be picked up on Release Day; any remaining will be donated or discarded the following day.

5. All baked foods & any associated ribbons, placards, or containers not picked up as indicated above will be discarded or recycled.

6. Any & all awards are awarded at discretion of the judges; decisions are final.
