Timeline & Rules

Enter Online → On or before Wednesday, June 10 at marinfair.org.
A 2020 Registration Fee of \$1 per person will apply.

Entry Fee → \$4.50 per Guinea Pig - No Entry Fee for Showmanship, but include showmanship on entry form. Entry Fee includes Fair admission. Refer to Rule #5.

Entry Limit → None

Arrival Time → Wednesday, July 1, 7 am to 9 am, Barnyard

Mandatory Meeting for Exhibitors and Parents →

Wednesday, July 1, 10 am, Fur & Feathers Tent

Breed Judging → Wednesday, July 1, 11 am

Showmanship → Wednesday, July 1, following breed judging,
Workshop followed by Novice, Primary, Junior, & Senior

Awards Ceremony → Wednesday, July 1, 3 pm

Departure Time → Wednesday, July 1, 3:30 pm to 6 pm

- 1. Eligibility:** Open to California junior residents 5 through 18 years of age.
- 2. Cages:** This is a one-day carry-in cage show. All carrying cages must have waterproof bottoms.
- 3. Rules:** Definition and judging procedures as prescribed in the latest edition of the Guide Book and the Standard of the American Rabbit Breeders Association, Inc. shall apply to all District and County Fair cavy shows, provided they do not conflict with any of the rules and regulations prescribed by the Division of Fairs and Expositions of the Department of Food and Agriculture.
- 4. Entry Forms & Fees:** Enter online at marinfair.org.
- 5. Credentials:** Each exhibitor will receive one admission credential and one combined admission/parking credential. Limit of one parking credential per family. You will also receive a map showing directions to the Fairgrounds.
- 6. Disqualification:** A judge or fair management may remove a cavy from competition if it appears to be fatigued or out of condition.
- 7. Identification:** All animals must be identified by permanent ear marking or ear tag conforming with the entry form on arrival at the show. Any duplication of ear tattoo by one exhibitor in the same division must be eliminated and the change recorded on the judging sheet before judging. No tattooing is permitted on the fairgrounds. For further information or assistance with ear tags or tattooing call the Fair Entry Office at 415.473.7048.
- 8. Ownership:** Entrants must have owned their animals 30 days prior to closing date of Fair entries.

9. **Liability:** Fair Management is not responsible for cavies if illness or death occurs.
10. **Exhibit Reclaim:** Entries must be picked up in person, or any other person must have a signed letter or authorization from the exhibitor.
11. **Guinea Pig Area is Air Conditioned.**

Division will be divided according to number of entries.

Class

- 1 Senior Boar - Over 32 ounces
- 2 Senior Sow - Over 32 ounces
- 3 Intermediate Boar - 22 ounces & up to & including 32 ounces, up to six months of age.
- 4 Intermediate Sow - 22 ounces & up to & including 32 ounces, up to six months of age.
- 5 Junior Boar - Min weight of 12 ounces & max weight of 22 ounces, up to 4 months old.
- 6 Junior Sow - Min weight of 12 ounces & max weight of 22 ounces, up to 4 months old

Class (Age as of January 1, 2020.)

- 7 Novice - A novice is someone who has never competed in a Guinea Pig (Cavy) Showmanship contest before regardless of age.
- 8 Primary - 5 through 8 years of age
- 9 Junior - 9 through 12 years of age
- 10 Senior - 13 years of age and over
