Timeline & Rules

Enter Online → On or before Wednesday, June 10 at marinfair.org.

A Registration Fee of \$1 per person will apply. **Please enter early.**

Space is limited. When area is full, no more entries will be accepted.

New! All livestock entries must be submitted online.

Entry Fee → \$3.50 Per Class, including groups
No entry fee for showmanship.

Entry Limit → None

Arrival Time → Wednesday, July 1, 7 am to 9 am

Judging Time → Wednesday, July 1, 11 am

Showmanship followed by individual classes

Departure Time → Wednesday, July 1, approximately 4 pm

1. Local and State Rules Govern this Competition.
2. Open to 4-H, FFA, and Independent Junior exhibitors 5 years through 19 years of age from California. Age as of January 1, 2020, except for special juniors who must be 5 years old as of July 1, 2020.
3. All animals must be N.P.G.A. registered. Copies of registration papers may be sent with entry, but original Registration Papers must be provided on the morning of the show.
4. Health Check: Only healthy animals may be entered. Any animals having runny noses and/or eyes or other obvious signs of illness will be requested to leave. The decision made by the show committee is final and entry fees will not be refunded.
5. Exhibitors must be bonafide owner of all entries 60 days prior to the show.
6. Classes may be combined if there are fewer than three entries per class.
7. The AMERICAN SYSTEM OF JUDGING will be used in all classes.
8. 4-H and FFA members must wear official uniforms in the ring for both showmanship and breed classes. Independent juniors must wear ankle length white pants and a white blouse or shirt.
9. Bedding (straw) will be provided by Fair.
10. Exhibitors must clean their stalls before departure.
11. Horned Pygmy Goats are allowed in the show.
