- 1. Eligibility:** The top two Showmanship (1st and 2nd Place) Winners in the Junior and Senior Divisions of the Poultry, Rabbit, Cavy, Pygmy Goat, and Dog Departments are eligible to compete in Round Robin Showmanship.
- 2. Credentials:** All participants will receive one fair admission credential and one combined fair admission/parking credential for Saturday, July 4.
- 3. Workshop:** There will be a Round Robin Training Workshop on Saturday, July 4 at 8:45 am. Please check-in by 8:30 am. All participants must be present at the Workshop at 8:45 am to participate. There is no entry fee for the Workshop.
- 4. Time & Location:** Small Animal Round Robin Showmanship will take place on Saturday, July 4 in the Demonstration Tent in the Barnyard beginning with Juniors at 9:30 am followed by Seniors at 10:30 am.
- 5. Note:** Exhibitors will be required to show Rabbits, Guinea Pigs (Cavies), Poultry, Pygmy Goats, and Dogs.
- 6. Awards:** The Round Robin awards will be presented on Sunday, July 5 at 4 pm in the Fur and Feathers Tent.
