To Enter: either **Register Online** by Monday, June 1 at marinfair.org
or **deliver your Entry Form** by Thursday, May 14, 5 pm, Fair Office
2020 Registration Fee: \$1 per person online, \$2 per person via paper form

Eligibility → Open to California residents.

Entry Limit → Two Entries per Class, unless otherwise noted

Entry Fee → \$5 Per Entry – Adults → \$3 Per Entry – Juniors
Fee must accompany Entry Form.

Exhibits Received → Friday, June 5, 3 pm to 7 pm, Exhibit Hall
& Saturday, June 6, 10 am to 5 pm, Exhibit Hall

Exhibits Released → Tuesday, July 7, 12 Noon to 7 pm, Exhibit Hall

1. Local and State Rules govern this competition.
2. **Eligibility:** Open to all residents of the USA.
3. **Entry Procedure:** Register online at marinfair.org. Entry forms may also be obtained at the Fair Office. See deadlines above.
4. **Exhibit Reclaim:** Entries must be picked up on release day. Entries will only be released by presenting your claim check, personal identification, or a signed letter of authorization from the exhibitor.
5. **Liability:** Every precaution will be taken in the handling and exhibiting of work; however, the Fair will not be responsible for loss or damage which may occur from any cause. Submission of entries implies acceptance of all conditions stated in these rules.
6. **General:** Accepted works SHALL NOT BE REMOVED from the show prior to pickup dates as stated in these rules. Works must remain as installed.
